

Official Interpretation Issued by the USMS Rules Committee
Event Limits in USMS and USA Swimming Meets

Rule 102.6 says that a swimmer may compete in not more than six individual events per day when events are conducted in a timed finals format.

When competing in a USMS sanctioned meet, the daily event limit is determined by considering all events, conforming and non-conforming, swum at any USMS sanctioned meet on the same day. Events swum at USA Swimming sanctioned meets or at other recognized meets do not count towards the daily limit.
